MINUTES OF COMMISSION MEETING
OCTOBER 28, 2019

The Cornelia City Commission met in a Called Meeting on Monday, October 28, 2019 at 6 PM in the City Hall Conference Room, 181 Larkin Street. Mayor Irby called the meeting to order with the following members present: Commissioner Don Bagwell, Tony Cook and Wesley Dodd, Jr. Commissioner Janice Griggs was not present. Also present: City Manager Donald Anderson, Jr. and Janie N. Henderson, Secretary to the City Commission.

City Manager Anderson stated the purpose of the meeting is to hold the first of three Public Hearings to present the 2019 Millage Rate. The value of our tax digest increased by \$2,355,220 in 2019 and based on this the Roll Back Rate would be 8.398%. If we keep the millage rate at 8.5%, our revenue will increase by \$16,081; which will result in a tax increase of 1.21%. We are recommending leaving the millage rate at 8.5%.

No one from the public was present for the Public Hearing. The Public Hearing was closed. Commissioner Bagwell made the motion to leave the millage rate at 8.5 mils; seconded by Commissioner Cook. Approved 3 -0.

Commissioner Dodd made the motion to close the meeting at approximately 6:05 PM and enter Executive Session to discuss Real Estate; seconded by Commissioner Bagwell. Approved 3 – 0.

Commissioner Dodd made the motion to close the Executive Session and open the meeting at approximately 6:08 PM; seconded by Commissioner Cook. Approved 3-0.

Mayor Irby stated a Real Estate was discussed and no action was taken.

Commissioner Dodd made the motion to adjourn the meeting at approximately 6:10 PM; seconded by Commissioner Bagwell. Approved 3 – 0.
